# **Go-live Overview**

### **Direct Web Browser**

• Shared Health managed sites/users:

A limited pre-release of eChart 2022 is planned for November 7, 2022, at 09:00 hrs. Impacted workstations will display eChart 2022 (Pre-Release) at log in. If you log in before 0900 hrs., you may not see the change until you log back in.

• All other sites/users:

eChart 2022 will be available to all eChart users using a supported web browser on November 14, 2022 at 09:00 hrs.

#### Token

• External access to eChart 2022 (via token/FOB) is underway and will be available at a later date. Details will be shared as they become available.

# Electronic Medical Record (EMR) eChart launch button

• Regionally managed sites/users:

eChart 2022 integration is underway for regionally managed EMR instances. Details will be shared as they become available.

• Non-Regionally managed sites/users:

Contact your vendor about how to access eChart 2022 once it becomes available on November 14, 2022.

#### **Electronic Patient Record (EPR) integration**

• EPR integration with eChart 2022 is underway and will be available at a later date. Details will be shared as they become available.

EMR and EPR users can still access eChart 2022 directly using a supported web browser.
