

Beginning Dec. 7, 2023, the Medication Card located in the List Pane will display Form (1), Duration with units (2), and Dispensed quantity (3) as shown in the screenshot below. This change allows users to view these details without having to click the card to view the Detail Pane. This is a short-term solution to address user challenges viewing medication history. We continue to work with the vendor to further address user feedback. Please share this message with your eChart users.
