



eChart 2022 offers many benefits and addresses feedback shared with us in past surveys:

- Replaces Internet Explorer with modern browsers
 - Supported browser/operating system combinations:
 - Windows 8.1, 10 or 11 with Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge (Chromium)
 - macOS with Safari
 - Modern browsers improve search functionality. For example, search using partial or specific words to find a drug within the date parameters of the patient record
- New configurable user preferences
 - Personalize preferences for basic settings and save them as a default, such as selecting preferred text size and expanding or collapsing categories in the Category View
- New flexible screen sizing
 - Increase the size of your eChart window to take advantage of your full screen
 - Adjust the List Pane to expand Card details
- New visual indicator for Patient Searches illustrates the strength of the field/s chosen when entering patient details
- Improved graphic trend results
 - Change date parameters using a timeline slider in trend view
 - Review specific collection details for a single result within the graphical view
- Workflow efficiencies for overriding Disclosure Directives
- Adobe software is no longer required to view or print clinical data

Direct web browser access to eChart 2022 is targeted to be available this fall, with EMR and EPR integration methods (e.g., eChart launch from a patient record) to follow.
