**Important information about eChart:**

eChart Manitoba is the provincial electronic health record, and as such, is adjunct to the information available to you at your point of care. eChart presents electronic information reported by contributing source systems (e.g., labs, diagnostic imaging) that is matched to the provincial health identifying information for the patient (e.g., 9-digit PHIN). eChart should not be considered a full record of care provided to the patient or a complete record of the information from those contributing source systems. Information in the system is updated regularly, and therefore printing information for the purpose of placing it on a medical record is not recommended.
